

Study tour to Strasbourg: planned programme (12.02.-15.02.2023)

- **Sunday 12.02.2023:** Arrival in Strasbourg around 16:00 Central Station with Frankfurt airport shuttle; check-in at the hotel, dinner and first visit of the city in the evening, dinner at Schnockeloch.
- **Monday, 13.02.2023:** morning guided tour of the city in the most important places, including European history, the importance of the city as a symbol of German-French reconciliation after 1945; lunch and afternoon with the Secretary General of the EAT, Mr Jean-Claude Gonon: discussion "Young people and Europe" in French; at 17:00 arrival of the participants at the European Parliament and from 18:00 participation in an evening of discussion at the invitation of the MEP, Mag.Mandl.
- **Tuesday 14.02.2023:** morning guided tour of the Council of Europe followed by a round table with Mr. Jean-Claude Gonon and a group of young French people, discussion and elaboration of a position paper on the current situation of the EU; afternoon meeting with Ambassador Dr. Wergötter at the Permanent Representation of Austria to the Council of Europe with discussion on various European topics. Late afternoon and free evening.
- **Wednesday 15.02.2023:** Spoke at the European Court of Human Rights and exclusive guided tour at 10:00 with Dr. Carlo Ranzoni, Judge (FL), followed by a series of questions and discussions. Lunch and departure at 16:45 from Strasbourg Central Station by Shuttle to Frankfurt Airport; at 21:45 return flight with LH to Vienna.
